



## YOUR WINTER GUIDE TO GETTING AROUND BRECKENRIDGE



### LEAVE THE DRIVING TO US!

Whether you are vacationing with the entire family, enjoying a relaxing weekend for two, or making your way to work, the Breckenridge Free Ride is designed to make your transit experience pleasant and easy. The best part – it's free! The Summit Stage is available for FREE travel to our neighboring communities of Frisco, Silverthorne, Dillon, Summit Cove, and Keystone – [www.summitstage.com](http://www.summitstage.com).

**COVID-19 Protocols:** At Breck Free Ride, the safety of our riders and employees is paramount. For that reason, we have adopted several health protocols including daily health screenings for employees, limiting capacity, requiring face coverings for all riders, rear door loading and unloading, and maintaining physical distancing requirements as much as possible. (Family members may sit together).

### Schedules & Routes

Visit the My Free Ride app for real-time information for the Breckenridge Free Ride transit system. Use the app to mark favorite stops and routes, set reminders, get alerts, plan your trip, provide feedback and access general information about the Free Ride. You can also visit [www.breckfreeride.com](http://www.breckfreeride.com) for schedules and routes. Printed copies of the schedule & system map are available inside the Breckenridge Welcome Center, inside Breckenridge Station, or on-board any Free Ride bus.

### Breckenridge Station

Breckenridge Station is located at 150 Watson Avenue at the base of the Breck Connect Gondola. It is the central hub for the Town's public transportation providers. The Free Ride Transit System and the Summit Stage use the Breckenridge Station to transfer passengers and to provide access to the Breck Connect Gondola for express service to Peaks 7 and 8. (There is no parking at Peaks 7 & 8).

Fifteen-minute drop-off parking is available across from Breckenridge Station in the South Gondola Lot.

### Lodging Shuttles

Some lodging groups provide free shuttle service with convenient stops located throughout town. If your lodging company provides a shuttle, look for this sign. (It will be numbered).



### PARKING (if you must)

If you choose to drive your own vehicle to Breckenridge, here are a few options. Please keep in mind that parking is prohibited on all town streets unless otherwise posted.

### FREE PARKING

#### Free Park & Ride

All-day free parking is available at the Airport Road and Ice Rink Lots. Free Ride services both lots continuously throughout the day.

#### Fifteen-Minute Free Parking

Fifteen minute free parking is available in most locations (license plate must be registered at machine or on mobile app).

### PAY PARKING

#### Downtown Paid Parking

There are over 1,000 paid parking spaces Downtown. Pay parking is enforced 365 days a year. **The easiest way to pay for parking is with the Passport Parking App (Android/Apple).** When you use our pay by phone system you can extend your parking from anywhere, receive text or push reminders before your parking expires, stop your parking session, and easily track your payments. Payment is required each time a vehicle changes location. Visit [BreckPark.com](http://BreckPark.com) for parking locations, rates, and maps. The rate is \$.50 for the first hour and increases for each subsequent hour.

#### Pay by Phone

Use your smart phone to conveniently pay for parking before ever leaving your car.



1. Download the Passport Parking app (Apple/Android) or visit [www.PassportParking.com](http://www.PassportParking.com) in your web browser.

2. Enter your zone number and follow instructions. Zone numbers are location specific and are posted on each block and on each meter.
3. Once time has expired, vehicle must be moved to a different location/zone in order to begin a new session.

### Pay at the Meter



Pay parking meters are conveniently located on each block (1-3 per block face).

1. Enter license plate number. We recommend taking a picture of your license plate to ensure accuracy.
2. Follow on screen instructions..
3. Retain receipt for proof of purchase and expiration time. (There is no need to display in vehicle).
4. Before time expires, you can return to any meter in the same block or zone to add time using the same license plate.
5. Once time has expired, vehicle must be moved to a different location/zone in order to begin a new session.

### Overnight Parking

Overnight parking for passenger and over-sized vehicles is available at the Airport Road Lot on Airport Road. The cost is \$5 per night Mon-Thur and \$10 per night Fri-Sun for a maximum of 14 nights. (Overnight on-street parking is prohibited year round).

### LOCAL TIPS

#### Avoid I-70 Traffic

Skipping the weekend afternoon rush between 1pm and 7pm will greatly shorten your drive time. Real-time traffic information and the traffic forecast are available at [www.gol70.com](http://www.gol70.com).

#### New Parking Garage

The new South Gondola parking garage is open. The garage has 950 parking spaces conveniently located at 151 Watson Ave across from Breckenridge Station and Breck Connect Gondola. Park all day for one rate, then walk downtown to shop and eat (no need to move your vehicle).

### Free After 3 PM Parking.

The Wellington Lot and Tiger Dredge Lot (winter only) are available for free parking AFTER 3 pm. These lots are easy to find and are perfect for dining and shopping.

### Walk a Block–Save a Buck.

South Main Street is the most expensive and busiest parking option. Park on Ridge Street and walk to Main Street to save money.

**Planning to spend more than a couple hours downtown?** The Tiger Dredge Lot has more availability and is cheaper than Main Street. Mon-Thurs all day parking is \$6.50. Weekend parking is \$12.

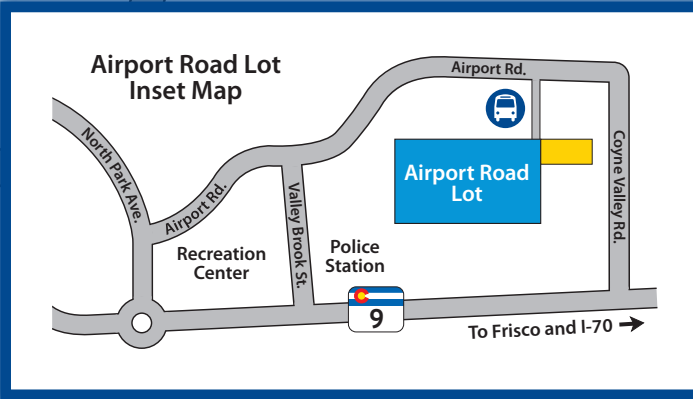
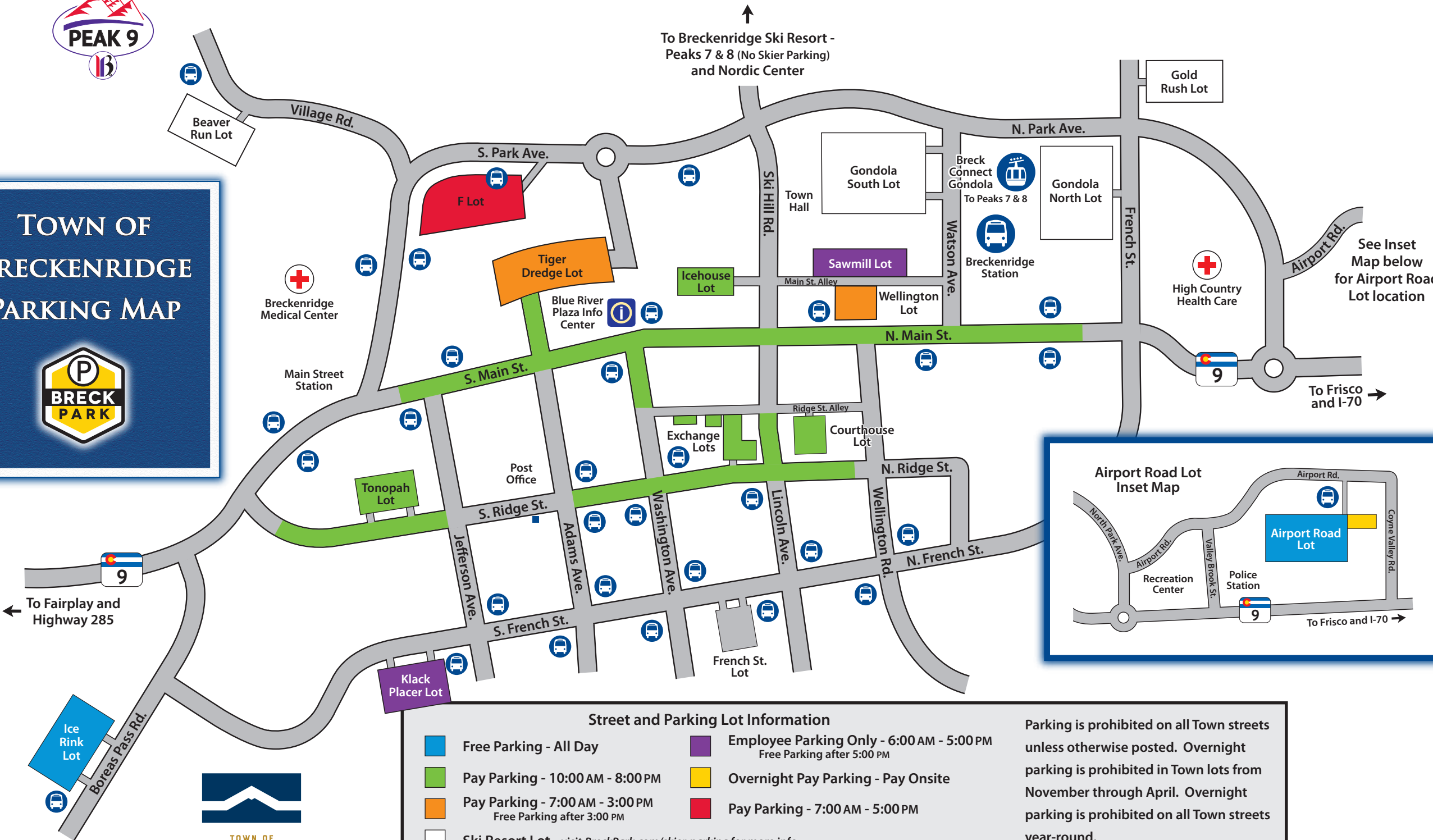

## Pay by Phone Instructions



The Passport Parking app is available for Apple and Android phones and provides the most convenient way to park - pay - and be on your way. To start a parking session, you'll first need to find your zone number. Zone numbers are posted on signs on every block as well as on each meter. Below is a complete list of zone numbers for quick reference. Enter your license plate, length of stay, payment information and off you go. (See reverse side for additional Pay by Phone and Pay at the Meter information).
